Dr. Rust serves as Artist Faculty-Piano/Professor and head of the piano department at the Lynn University Conservatory of Music in Boca Raton, Florida, where she received the "Deanne and Gerald Gitner and Family Excellence in Teaching Award." In summer 2022 she joined the faculty of the Adamant Music School in Vermont and served on the faculty of the Rebecca Penneys Piano Festival in Tampa, Florida for a tenth year.

She has given master classes at Northwestern University, the San Francisco Conservatory, the Thornton School of Music at the University of Southern California, and throughout Asia and the Americas. Rust has been presented in performances and master classes at the Manila International Piano Masterclasses Festival. University of Florida International Piano Festival and the Fondation Bell'Arte International Certificate for Piano Artists program. She has adjudicated competitions at the Symphony, World Chautaugua and Brevard Festivals, and the Colburn School's Music Academy.




